LEOA Board of Directors:

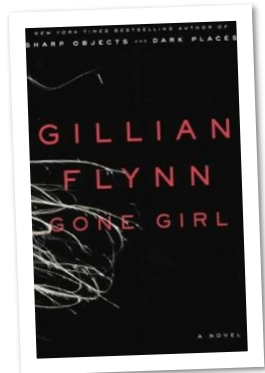
